iii Accessibility Coordinator's Update -

- Andrea worked with NCAM and CNIB to arrange for the braille in NCAM signage to be confirmed for accuracy.
- The bidding for the emergency exits ramp project has begun.
- Andrea attended the Ontario Network of Accessibility Professionals (ONAP) conference. Some highlights were that changes to the barrier-free design rules in the Ontario Building Code took effect on January 1, 2025. Andrea will investigate this further to gather information on the changes. A session on artificial intelligence (AI) talked about how AI can be biased, especially when it collects information about people with disabilities and other marginalized groups."
